## **Therapy Days**

On June 12 you will have the opportunity to make different small items namely a bowl cozy, a folded star, plastic bag holder, pot holder or a pocketed mug rug. The supplies needed for each of these items is included in this newsletter. You can also come that day and watch how each is made. Feel free to come and sew even if you haven't signed up for any of the classes.

Therapy day on July 10 will be Laura Patridge teaching a sampler table runner consisting of four blocks. Of course



you can take the four blocks and use them any way that you wish. I hope that many of you will sign up for that class as that is one item that was requested by members to have for therapy day. It seems that the same people come each month for Therapy Day. This is a good way to get to know other members in the club and learn a new technique. The cost of the class is \$25 which should be paid to Judy Pearson. A picture of the table runner is attached.

The Therapy Day on August 14 will be Nancy Sapin teaching us how to make rope bowls. Nancy Harris gave us a preview of the bowl that she had made during our last meeting.

The program for June is about vintage quilts by Jeannine James. She invites you to bring

your vintage quilts to the meeting with any questions or concerns you may have about it. She is willing to give some tips to you about your vintage quilt.

# Supplies for the June Therapy Day

#### **Bowl Cozy**

The only supplies needed are two 10" fabric squares. I will provide precut 10" batting squares. Bring general supplies, like sewing machine & thread, pins, chalk or marking pen. Judy Abernethy is bringing a "cozy" ruler to share.

#### Mug Rug

- 6 10' squares of fabric. They can be all different or you can use two of each of three different fabrics
- 1 10" square of soft and stable batting
- 1 yard of medium or large ric rat

A nine inch plate or a clear round circular template that measures 9" across Sewing machine, thread and basic sewing accessories.

#### **Bag Holder**

#### Stars

Lining fabric. 20" x 25' Exterior Fabrics: (9) strips of 3-1/2" x 20" 1/4" Elastic: 11" for top and 6-1/2" for bottom Sewing machine and basic sewing ssupplies Four strips of coordinating fabric 4"x 14" Fabric can be the same or four different fabrics Please starch each strip and have it pressed . This is a no sew project so we will use an iron but it will be provided.
