Burke Quilters Guild General Meeting Minutes

May 22, 2023

No secretary report, Glenda Huffman was out on vacation. Dinah Weaver will be taking minutes today. Judy Pearson, Treasurer, stated that we have a guild income of \$10,679.06. We had expenses that totaled \$200.00 and income of \$35.60. Our total to date is \$10,514.66.

Nancy Harris asked that the articles, quilt show information, or any information be given to her by this Thursday June 29 and to please keep in mind that she will not be publishing a newletter in August so for everyone to send things in advance. Linda Henson told the group that there were forms available for challenge or non-challenge quilts for the quilt show for anyone that wanted them to be filled out in advance.

Phyllis Foxx stated that she had sent out E cards for birthdays the last month and sent get well and sympathy cards. Phyllis did state she is low on stamps. Phyllis also wished everyone a Happy 4th.

Dinah Weaver stated that she gave the hospital 30 quilts and 5 quilts to the Sherriff Dept in Morganton.

Terri Martino stated that she has a lot of blocks for the veterans quilt. 2 quilts are laid out to put together and one is complete.

Linda Henson stated that Hospice gives a mini patriotic quilt to her deceased brother in law and it was precious and Bernice cried over it. There were suggestions made that that would be a good project for our guild to think about.

Linda Henson stated that we will be having a therapy day July 10 with Laura Patridge to make a table runner. August 14th we have rope bowl class by Nancy S.apine from Franklin We had samples at the sign in table of examples of the bowls we will be making with pendants. The pendants will be available for purchase as well



during the class and kits will be 12.00. We will also need a zig zag foot. Class fee is 25.00 Members were encouraged to participate. October 9th will be Augusta Cole class and we need at least 20 people to sign up. Linda Henson stated that if we didnt' have many to sign up that she would have to cancel the class. Judy Pearson stated if members didn't have money with them today that we could mail a check to her.

Judy Brittain stated that the hospitality committe is planning a nice quilt luncheon August 28th and the fee is 10.00 per person.

Our Program for July will be Judy Zimmerman showing a trunk show and quilt show judging.

Dawn LaDuc showed the ribbons for the quilt show that have been completed and they are beautiful. Dawn stated that we are going to have to buy more supplies to make more ribbons. Shirley Speagle made the ribbons. There is a quilt show meeting planned for July 10 before the therapy program. Also the entry form for the quilt show will be included in the newsletter.

NEW BUSINESS: A donation quilt was discussed for this year and a vote was in favor to have a fundraiser quilt this year. Phyllis Foxx stated it would be good to have someone in charge of the donation quilt. Cindy Kornarski has the pattern and materials were donated so everything for the top is ready. Joanne suggested we have a patriotic quilt that people might would like that as a raffle quilt. Teri Martino stated she would print the tickets for free.

Linda Henson stated that Linda Myers needs volunteers for the nominating committee There are two volunteers as of now. Please contact Linda if you are willing to serve.

Meeting was adjourned and Show and Tell followed.
