Date: March 25, 2024

Welcome: President Judy Abernethy opened our meeting and welcomed our returning member, Cheryl Svendsen.

Minutes: The minutes of February 24, 2024 were read.

Treasurer: Our last ending balance was \$9,304.00. Look for the treasurer's report in the newsletter.

Sunshine and Shadows: Phyllis Fox fell, broke her arm and will be out of commission for weeks. Perhaps we should send her cards.

Wee Care Quilts: Dinah Weaver donated 36 Wee Care Quilts to the hospital NICU and 4 to the Sherriff's Department. Batting is available for donation quilts.

Veteran Quilts: The Senior Center asked for a Veteran Quilt to be donated for Memorial Day this year. Cindy Konarski has one to donate. We should plan ahead so we have one for both Memorial Day and Veterans' Day in the future.

Newsletter: Photos from all quilts from "Show and Tell" will be on the website and the larger ones will be added to the newsletter.

Programs: The Sign-up sheets for the Workshops/Therapy Days are on the Sign-In table. "Pick Up Sticks by Strip Tubing" taught by JoAnn Estes will be April 8th. Brenda Brown's "Bag Class" will be on May 12 with the cost of \$15, plus supplies. The majority of those interested voted on making the "zippered project bag".

Show and Tell: Several members presented quilts for "Show and Tell", including one rope bowl made in the March Therapy Day. Of the quilts shown today, 5 were donations for the NICU and 2 were for the Sherriff's Department.



Today's Program: JoAnn Estes presented her "Trunk Show". JoAnn's inspiration was her Grandmother, who was born in 1906, lived on farms in Nebraska and Kansas and was a Utilitarian Quilter. JoAnn's presentation began with one of her grandmother's quilts made from feed sacks and used clothing, including a dress her grandmother wore in a family photo. She also made a quilt for JoAnn's wedding present. Later, JoAnn used the same pattern to make a quilt using scraps from her own sewing projects. JoAnn showed us quilts with embroidery, panel quilts, challenge quilts, block of the month quilts and hand appliqued quilts. These were just some of over 100 quilts JoAnn has made in her fifty years of quilting.

Pick Up Sticks

70" x 81"

JoAnn Estes, Instructor

Supply List:

- 36 Dark/Medium 2 ½" x Width of Fabric strips (Minimum of 42")
- 44 Light 2 ½" x Width of Fabric strips (Minimum of 42")
- or 3 1/3 yards light background fabric (this includes fabric for 2" inner border)
- 2 yds. Dark fabric for outer border and binding
- 90 degree triangle ruler (I use the Omnigrad right triangle for 8" quilting ruler). It can be found on Amazon for \$10.79
- Sewing Machine (with extra thread and bobbins)
- Seam Ripper (Must have for this method of assembly)
- Iron/Ironing Board (Optional - Can use the ones provided in class)
- Rotary Cutter/Cutting Mat
- Assorted quilting supplies as you think you will need... (Pins, scissors, etc.)
