President's Message

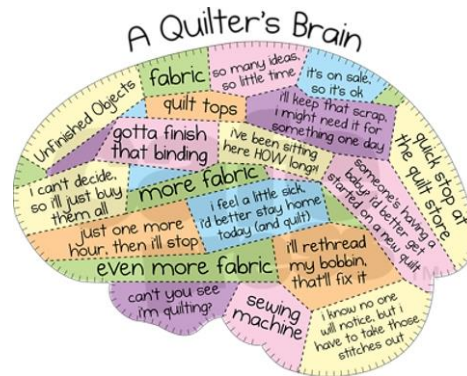

Date: April 22, 2024

Welcome: President Judy Abernethy opened our meeting and welcomed our visitor, Frances Burroughs and new member, Gloria Vodan. Each one spoke to introduce themselves.

Minutes: The minutes of March 25 were read and approved.

Treasurer: Treasurer, Judy Pearson reported that we had a beginning balance of \$9,070.81, plus \$42.00 in income, less \$85.94 in expenses, leaving the ending balance of \$9,026.87.

Sunshine and Shadows: Susan Briggs reported that Phyllis Fox sends her love and appreciates the cards sent.

Wee Care Quilts: Dinah Weaver donated 24 Wee Care Quilts to the hospital NICU and 4 to the Sherriff's Department.

Veteran Quilts: Terri Martino and Cindy Konarski showed a Veteran quilt started by long time member, Frieda Berry. Terry finished it and Cindy quilted it to give to the Veteran's office. Terri has another member quilt to honor Jordon O'Hearn, the son of Rosie, a volunteer at the Senior Center. Additional patriotic blocks are available to make Veterans quilts.

Programs: Due to early voting, meeting locations or dates have been changed. The next Therapy Day will be Brenda Brown's "Bag Class" on May 13 with the cost of \$15, plus supplies. The "zippered project bag" workshop will be held at Calvary Lutheran Church, 119 N. King Street, Morganton. Our May 20 program will be "Modern Quilts" by Patricia Cone.

Show and Tell: Members presented quilts for "Show and Tell", including a beautiful Grandmother's Flower Garden Quilt finished for a family member. Several Veterans and baby quilts were donated. It's always nice to hear the stories that go along with quilts made.

Today's Program: A program on "Sewing Ergonomics" was presented by Joanne Hinkle, a former PE teacher and Physical Therapist Assistant. Joanne emphasized the importance of sewing with level wrists, with elbows and knees at a 90 degree angle, back straight, feet flat on the floor and eyes focused on the needle. Joanne engaged the group in exercises to correctly rise from a chair, balance, bend, turn and gave ideas of exercises to improve balance and muscle strength. Joanne encouraged a quality of life and suggested using Silversneakers.com.
